Delivery of the Curriculum and Pastoral Care

Discovery Educational Trust (DET) and its Schools use personal information, for example:

- Names and address
- Contact details
- Date of birth
- Education attainment
- Emergency contacts
- Family relationships
- General case information

DET and its Schools also use some special category personal information, for example:

- Health information
- Ethnicity
- Religion

This information is provided by parent/carers, the Local Authority (LA) and any previous education settings. It is used to deliver DET/its Schools' statutory education duties and assure the health and wellbeing of DET/its Schools' pupils.

Each DET School is the Data Controller for this information.

This information may be shared in order to provide DET/School education service. Please note that DET/its Schools only share information required for that particular purpose and then only the minimum required. DET and its Schools may share information with:

- Health Providers
- Other Education Providers
- Regulatory Bodies, e.g. Ofsted, The Information Commissioners Office

This information is held for 25 years from the date of birth of the pupil. When a pupil changes school, this record goes with them and is not retained by the previous school, other than to meet statutory returns.

The DET/School management system is provided under contract and the third party to this contract acts as Data Processor for this information.

No personal information is routinely available outside of the UK. Should a transfer of personal information be necessary, DET/its Schools only do so where it is permitted by law and where appropriate safeguards are in place.
